Psalm 145:1-7 NIV

A psalm of praise. Of David.

¹ I will exalt you, my God the King;
I will praise your name for ever and ever.

² Every day I will praise you
and extol your name for ever and ever.

³ Great is the LORD and most worthy of praise; his greatness no one can fathom.

- ⁴ One generation commends your works to another; they tell of your mighty acts.
- ⁵ They speak of the glorious splendor of your majesty—and I will meditate on your wonderful works.^[5]
- ⁶ They tell of the power of your awesome works—and I will proclaim your great deeds.
- ⁷ They celebrate your abundant goodness and joyfully sing of your righteousness.

Exalt – Praise – Commend – Tell – Speak Meditate – Proclaim – Celebrate – Sing

- What is our response ability? It's WORSHIP.
- Our worship not only reminds US of God's <u>works</u>, <u>mighty acts</u>, <u>splendor</u>, <u>majesty</u>, <u>wonder</u>, <u>power greatness</u>, <u>goodness</u>, and <u>righteousness</u>, but it reminds "one generation... to another" (v.4)
- One generation will pass onto the next a "language of praise"

Ephesians 5:19-20 NIV

¹⁹ speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit. Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord, ²⁰ always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- Paul instructs us to sing to one another
- Our ability to respond with praise and <u>proclaim the works</u>, <u>mighty acts</u>, <u>splendor</u>, <u>majesty</u>, <u>wonder</u>, <u>power greatness</u>, <u>goodness</u>, <u>and righteousness</u> is for "one another".
- Opportunity for rest.
- Opportunity to delight in the Lord
